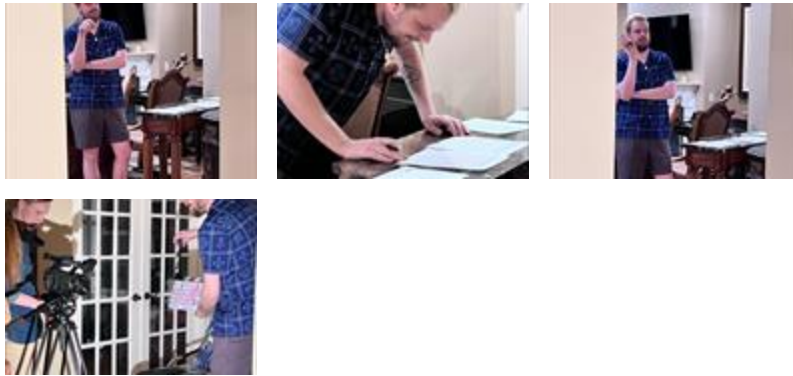

“ Blake,

This picture was taken on one of the happiest days of my life. Maybe the happiest. I know that sounds strange, because it was just a day of working a kind-of-crummy job as an extra on a film set. But you happened to be working that day too, and we ended up spending something like 14 hours together and I talked your ear off the entire time. If you know me, this sounds entirely out-of-character - and it is. But you were a person I could trust, who never judged, who listened to me for those 14 hours. You were the only person outside of my family who called me 'Lanny', and that felt right. It's like you knew, without ever hearing anyone call me that. You were family.

You had so much freedom, ease, intelligence in your acting. You inspired me in countless ways - you were the kind of person that inspires people to create art so they can work together, and we did. I made two films with you at their center, and I always thought we would work together again. Your brilliance was too great to not be shared with the world.

So much heart, so much empathy, so much compassion. When you were with a friend, you gave them your full self, your humor, your wisdom.

Working with you in class was a gift that led to leaps in my acting, and in my life. You gave me the courage to change my life in a huge way and I will forever be grateful for that.

I've been thinking about you a lot over the last few months, because this fall marked the ten year anniversary of us meeting each other at an acting program in San Francisco. I meant, many times, to reach out to you and set up a meeting, Bruce and I often talked about going to visit you in Nashville. I regret so much that I didn't make this happen. I know you would have been so proud of me, the life I've made with my work and with Bruce. We both loved you so

much. If we have had a proper wedding, Blake, you would have been the best man.

You were loved so much by so many people. You were so talented and had so much to give. I'm grateful to have had the opportunity to have you in my life. Love to your family. Rest in peace.
