of Nashville, TN. Age 81, passed away March 7, 2010. Sculptor and Educator. Listed in Who's Who in American Art. Graduated 1958, University of Washington, BFA; University of Oregon MFA in Sculpture, 1960. Sculpture instructor at Salford Technical College in England 1963-65, Professor of Sculpture, Western KY University 1965 -1992. He was a prolific artist creating over 500 pieces during his lifetime, the majority which were sold to collectors. He worked with the human form and in the abstract using the lost wax technique in bronze, and with wood and aluminum. His sculptures have been shown in many regional and national exhibits, receiving numerous awards. His artwork has been commissioned by the Springfield and Medford, Oregon public parks and the Shakespeare Memorial Theater in Oregon, the Bundy Art Museum in Vermont, Broughton School in England, Bowling Green-Warren Country Hospital, Northern Telecom in Nashville, and numerous private patrons. He was predeceased by his loving wife of 53 years, Dorothy Reese. He is survived by a daughter, Winnie Forrester of Nashville and son, John Forrester of Rome, Italy, and four grandchildren.
