Christopher Thomas Brown, 47 years old, of Lebanon, Tennessee died June 28, 2012 at Vanderbilt University Medical Center, after suffering a brain hemorrhage. Chris is preceded in death by his father, James Talmadge Brown, Sr. Chris leaves behind his wife Michelle, and four sons Valon, Dimitrius, Darius, and Rocky. He is survived by his mother Margaret, brothers James (Kathy), Stephen (Donna), Robert (Marla), and sister Myrna (Sundee Kainth), along with many loving nieces, nephews and other relatives.

Chris, a fourteen year veteran of the Air Force and Army had a stellar military career serving stateside and abroad. He fulfilled his career at Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri as a drill Staff Sergeant leading Company D, 5th Battalion, 10th Infantry Regiment.

Chris attended the Citadel in Charleston, SC where he studied Political Science.

During his second career, Chris was a self-employed painting contractor who was fortunate to have spent this time working with his brothers throughout the Middle Tennessee area. A lover of the outdoors and sports, Chris spent much of his free time pursuing his passion of golf and soccer. Chris was a private person, who prized relationships and placed great value on the quality of time spent with those he loved. Through organ donation, Chris's wife and son's were able to honor him by saving the lives of at least 4 people.
