Dennis Howard Donovan, 85, passed away February 21, 2018 in Chattanooga, TN. Dennis was born in Pittsburg, PA on June 13, 1932 to Dorothy Howard and James M. Donovan. He was a lifelong and devout Roman Catholic and until recently had been a longtime member of St. Patrick's Catholic Church in Nashville.
