Donald “Don” Peery, 75, passed away January 14, 2022, in Nashville, TN. He was the son of the late William “Bill” Peery and the late Macy Peery, owners of the Avalon Restaurant in Paris, TN for many years.

Don was a 1965 graduate of E. W. Grove High School and attended University of Tennessee, Martin, TN, and Tennessee State University, Nashville, TN.
