WOODY, Robert Dr., 91, of Hendersonville, TN, passed away June 25, 2012. He is preceded in death by his parents, John Robert Woody & Martha Mae Rearden; numerous brothers & sisters. He is survived by his loving wife of 63 years, Jean Woody; sister, Laura Cotter; daughters, Margaret Ellen Woody, Laura Mae (John) Ore & Martha (Ray) Minardi; grandson, Kyle Minardi; several nieces & nephews and extended family. He was called to the ministry over 70 years ago. He was awarded his Masters of Divinity at Southern Baptist Theological Seminary. He was awarded his Doctorate from the University of Mary Harding Baylor in Belton, TX where he served as a trustee. He was also a trustee of Belmont University. He was a member of Noon Sertoma for over 40 years. He was the first minister of Bluegrass Baptist Church serving as Pastor for 16 years and Pastor Emeritus until his death. He was called to ministry over 70 years ago. Funeral Services will be held 1pm Thursday at Bluegrass Baptist Church in Hendersonville with Rev. Matt Tullos officiating. Interment to follow 10am Friday at Hendersonville Memory Gardens. Active Pallbearers are friends of the family.
