George Bruce Sulfridge, 84, of Nashville, Tennessee, passed away on February 14, 2019, at Vanderbilt University Medical Center in Nashville due to complications following a stroke. George was born December 12, 1934, in Coeburn, Virginia, to William Fletcher and Lillie Francis (Gibson) Sulfridge. George graduated from Coeburn High School, and East Tennessee State University. He married Jackie Sanders of Coeburn Nov. 13, 1954. 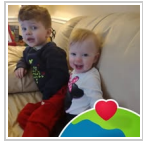
