Georgia Cozell Wilson Phelps, age 90, of Nashville, Tennessee, died November 22, 2021, in Skyline Medical Center, of pneumonia. She was born in Hermitage Springs Tennessee in 1931 to G.C. and Olyne Wilson. She lived in Nashville and graduated from Hume-Fogg High School before marrying Ben Phelps, Sr. and living for a short while in Lubbock, Texas while her husband was in the Air Force. 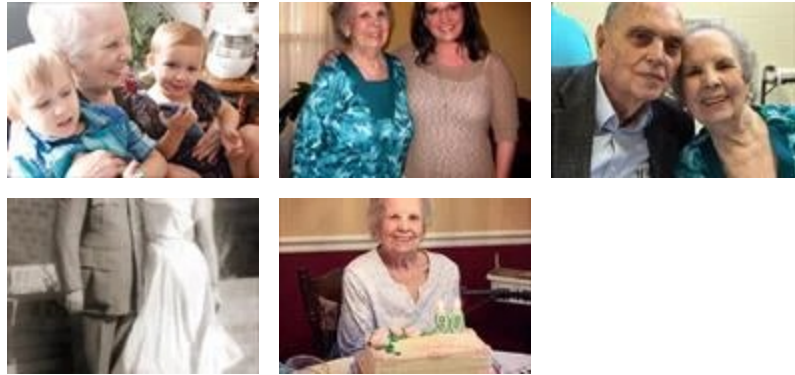
