BREW, John "J.B." went home to be with the Lord and his beloved wife, Mary Ruth (deceased in 2000), on July 21, 2014. A descendant of James Robertson, Nashville's founder, J.B. was born the eighth of nine children to Patrick and Mada (Drake) Brew on June 27, 1923, in Hendersonville, Tennessee. Having lovingly served at Valley View, Riverside, Edgefield, and Belmont Heights Baptist Churches, J.B. impacted many lives as a husband, father, Sunday School teacher, youth worker, choir member, deacon and encourager throughout his life.
