January 30, 1918 - June 26, 2011

Joe G. Denison of Nashville, 93 years old, died in Memphis at his daughter's home on June 26, 2011. He was born January 30, 1918 in Bauxite, Arkansas to Essie and Will Denison and was raised in Conway, Arkansas. He served in the US Army from 1941-1945 in the Aleutian Islands and as paratrooper in the 101st Airborne in Europe, including the D-Day battle. He was preceded in death by his wife of 57 years, Mary Hornsby Denison, from Consett UK and his son-in-law, Tom Lee, and all his siblings, Nannie Lou Wulff, Brud Denison, Helen Horst, and Louise Robison. Mr. Denison retired from both Swift and Company Ice Cream and Munford Corporation. Mr. Denison was blessed with a selfless heart for others. A lifelong Methodist, Mr. and Mrs. Denison taught kindergarten Sunday School at Dalewood United Methodist Church for 47 years where children of all ages waited outside the door to talk with him and get chewing gum.. His life was marked by a gift of giving joy and encouragement to others, especially to his family, friends, teenagers, and children.
