BROWN, Sr., John Douglas (Doug) of Nashville, TN, passed Tuesday, June 14, 2011 following an extended illness. Mr. Brown was retired from Alexander Metals, Inc. of Nashville, TN and Lowe's Companies, Inc. Mr. Brown graduated from Hume-Fogg Technical Vocation High School in 1951. Mr. Brown was an honorably discharged veteran of the Korean War where he served as a hospital corpsman and attained the rank of HM3.

Upon his return from US Naval service, Mr. Brown attended Vanderbilt University School of Engineering. He was happily married for 54 years to the former Mary E. Whitaker. Mr. Brown was a 32nd degree Mason. He was an active member of Dalewood United Methodist Church for 51 years.
