November 1, 1944 - July 10, 2025

With profound grief and enduring remembrance, we announce the passing of Julia Ann (Ballard) Lovell on July 10, 2025 at the age of 80 in Manchester, Tennessee.

Julia was born on November 1, 1944, in Oakdale, Louisiana to the late Timothy and Ledia (Manuel) Ballard. She entered the world as the ninth of thirteen children, seamlessly woven into the lively atmosphere of their home. 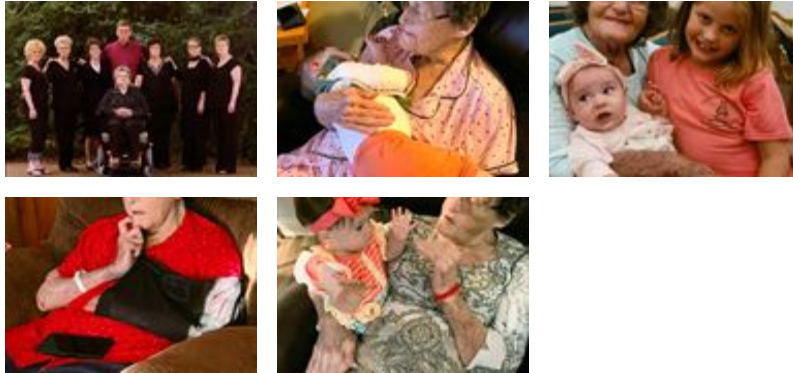
