Three years ago she was in the hospital for 2 weeks and her dr was ready to call in hospice. We said please don't mention that to her, let us take her home and we will care for her with the grace of God.

So 3 years ago we moved her in with us, for 6 of these months me and my husband gave total care to her, bathed and clothed, cooked and cared for her She had in home rehab for a year. Thank you Sydney Richey and the many others on her team of therapists. She regained her strength and was able to get around the house after that. But was not able to be alone for long . She had congestive heart failure among other things. She looked forward to getting her hair done every week by Donna Swann for many years .

She loved baking and shopping and talking on the phone she looked forward to Sandra , Bill and Linda calling every day. She loved her kids and grandchildren. She was a bit of a boss everyone knew it. She didn't think her children/girls could breathe/shower or cook unless she reminded them to. I think her favorite sayings were. "Where are you going""what are you doing" she always had advise to give her kids and grandchildren daily, we think that's what kept her going. She enjoyed church and the Sunday school Joy Class, when her eyes got so bad she couldn't read she stopped SS and just attended church until the covid hit.

We are thankful for everyone that was a part of her precious life she loved her church family. She loved Judy Kay Heth who would come and take Kathleen out at least two times a month shopping and almost every week would come down the street to sit and visit her. She loved her Dr Hill at St Thomas and she loved her almost weekly dr visits to get her blood checked so she could go visit the special people there Rick, Bonita, Carol, Donna, Teresa, Sharon and many more. The day before she passed she had a good day. She wanted egg salad , I told her I never made that you will need to help. (I have made it) I was just wanting her to help . So she made egg salad she

mashed up those eggs so much I said is it supposed to be baby food. We laughed , I cooked her fried Squash and Turnips and also made her a Carrot cake. She enjoyed it.

She was relaxing and I rubbed lotion on her legs and feet. Im thankful that was a good day.

I'm very thankful that we were able to care for her. My husband was a wonderful son to his mother after the passing of his daddy 30 years ago he stepped up and took her to movies and out to eat often. We often would take her to Dairy Queen on Sunday evenings . She loved sweets . He has seen his mother almost daily for the past 62 years. They definitely pushed each other's buttons at times but she knew he was a great loving and caring son.

The morning of her passing the light in the bathroom that she used as a nite lite for 3 years since she has been here just blew, burnt out! 💡

It truly did!

We will miss her greatly.

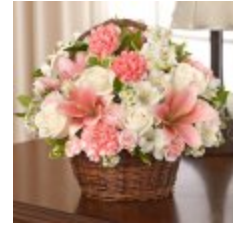

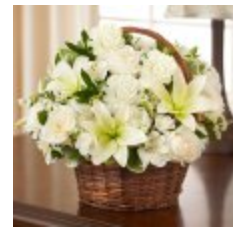
