



## Norma Roop

January 30, 1935 - January 2, 2017

Roop, Norma Katherine, age 81, died January 2, 2017 in Hendersonville, TN after a lengthy battle with cancer. She was preceded in death by her husband, Paul Roop; parents, Jerry D. and Zella (Henderson) Johnson; brother, Eugene Hunter Johnson.

She is survived by her brother Harry Lee Johnson (Carolyn); sister Frieda Callahan, son Daniel Roop (Mary Grace); daughter Elizabeth Little (Jim); grandchildren Justin, Jessica, and Jeremiah (Ellie) Roop.

Norma was a graduate of Meadowview High School and the Johnston Memorial Hospital School of Nursing in Abingdon, VA in 1955. She had a RN license in both Virginia and Tennessee, and had worked as a Medical-Surgical Nurse for several years. After staying home to raise her children, she resumed nursing again and began teaching LPN courses for the State of Tennessee in the Adult Education program in Bristol, TN. She also worked as a nurse at the Sullivan County, TN County Health Department. After retirement, she volunteered at several community Health Clinics.

Norma fought Multiple Myeloma for over 6 years through the aid of treatment through Vanderbilt -Ingram Cancer Hospital in Nashville, TN. She participated in a clinical study during her treatments.

Norma was a Christian and was a member of the Presbyterian Church in

Bristol, TN.

A graveside service will be conducted at 2:00 pm on Monday, January 9, 2017 at the Mausoleum of Knollkreg Memorial Park in Abingdon, VA. The family will accept visitors starting 1 hour prior to service.
