Polly was a decades-long employee of the Davidson County School System where she worked in the kitchen at both Isaac Litton and Stratton Elementary School, retiring as the Kitchen Manager for Stratton Elementary School when she was 62. She was a long-time active member of the Inglewood Methodist Church. She made regular donations to St. Mary's and also the Monteagle Cemetery.

Above all things, Polly was an adoring wife, mother and grandmother to three generations of grandchildren. The matriarch of five generations showered her

family with endless love, laughter, chocolate pies, banana bread, hugs, gin rummy, hand crafted gifts and pearls of wisdom. Her talents included knitting, crocheting and sewing as well as being a fantastic cook. She was sharp-witted, funny, caring and warm. She will be remembered as a strong woman with an unwavering will who laughed as hard as she worked for the entirety of her 91 years.
