Philip was born in Nashville on March 21, 1959 to Roy A.G. Smith and Martha Jane (née Stevens) Smith. He was a 1977 graduate of Stratford High School and received Bachelor of Arts from Norwich University (Montpelier, VT campus) in 2001.

A lifelong real estate professional, Philip began his career in the 1980s as a realtor with Century 21 in Madison, where he received Top Salesman of the Month recognition on more than one occasion. From 2002 until 2013, he was employed in the State of Tennessee Real Estate Asset Management Division as Contract Officer, negotiating contracts for land acquisitions and state park improvements.
