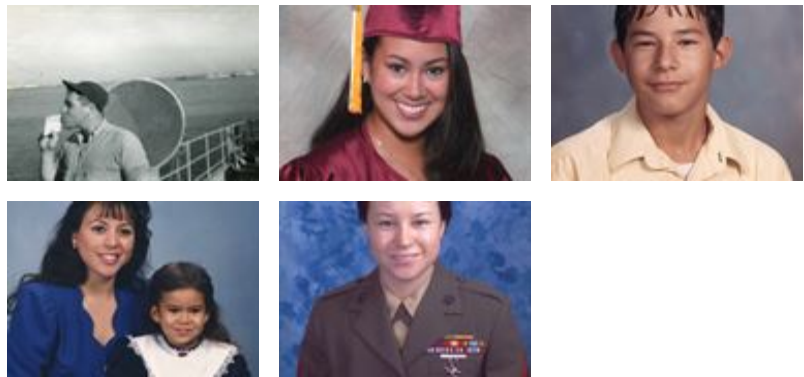
“ *Bini, David, Norman, and Darlene,*
