Phillip Ray Shuler, age 55, passed away June 18, 2016. Phil became a Christian when he was 13 years old and started singing Southern Gospel Music at the early age of 17 in East Tennessee. He worked in law enforcement for 30 years, beginning his career with the Washington County Sheriff's Department in 1984. On April 1, 1990, Phil began working for the Metro Nashville Police Department, where he served the city of Nashville until his retirement in 2013. During his time with the Metro Nashville Police Department he received awards for Outstanding Officer Over All, Excellence in Emergency Response, and the Nashville Outstanding DARE Officer for Glenclyff Middle School.
