Wright, Rick (also known as Richard W. Fagel Wright) was born October 31, 1958 passed away February 7, 2016 at age 57.

Rick was tragically killed in an auto accident near his home in White House, TN, on Sunday, February 7th. Born in Burbank, California, Rick moved with his mother and brother to Oklahoma City in 1971 where he began his musical career in his mother's band at the age of 14. He played with Jody Miller, Gary P. Nunn, Marty Stuart and many more. For over 20 years Rick was a highly respected session player before moving to Nashville where for the last 17 years he has been Connie Smith's lead guitar player.

Rick is survived by his wife, Sherrie Wright, a son Joshua Stonebraker, 2 grand daughters, his mother Linda Wright Piro, brothers Steve Wright and Joseph Piro, and uncle Joe Wright, 2 step sons, Nicholas Thomas of Florence KY and Jay Thomas of San Diego and 5 step grand children.
