Robert Kendell Norman Sr, 82, a beloved Nashville patriarch, sadly left this world on April 24th, 2025. He was born on March 23, 1943 in Nashville, TN to JD and Nina Norman. Known better as Kenny, he was known for his strong will and passionate beliefs. He worked at the Tennessean, and worked as a Court Officer within Metro Courts. He would later serve as Juvenile Court Clerk for 12 years. Kenny was a proud member of the Goodlettsville Masonic Lodge, Madison Elks Lodge and was a lifetime member of the Nashville Al Menah Shriners. He worked fearlessly and tirelessly in Nashville politics while volunteering for several campaigns. He also loved to work on the Norman farm and was a barbecue legend in his free time.

He is preceded in death by his mother, Nina Elizabeth Norman, and his father, JD Norman, Sr.; And his siblings, Barbara Haynes(Joe) and JD Norman Jr (Pat).

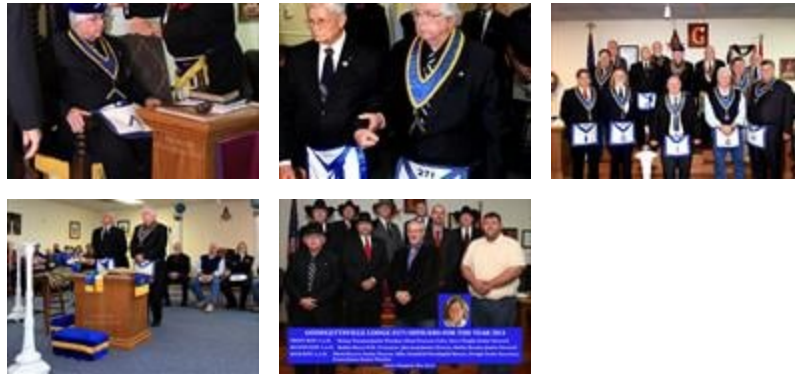
