Ronald H. Pugh, age 79 of Portland, TN, passed away from this life on Thursday, January 25, 2024. He was born September 27, 1944 and grew up in Madison, TN. Ronnie graduated from Isaac Litton High School and served his country in the US Army. He retired from Dupont after 35 years of service. After retiring he worked at and was a member of the Grand Ole Opry. He later worked for the Stagehands Local Union and the Manheim Auto Auction. Ronnie was also a member of Bush's Chapel Church of Christ in Gallatin. Ronnie was made a Master Mason 27 years ago at the Old Hickory Lodge #598, now Goodlettsville Lodge #271. He was initiated July 1, 1996, passed October 15, 1996, and raised January 27, 1997. He was a 32nd degree Scottish Rite Mason, a member of the Al Menah Shrine Temple, and a member of the Provost Guard, of which he was a Past Captain. Preceded in death by his wife, Beverly Kelley, and his mother, Laura "Polly" Pugh.
