Stanton Reynolds Goad, age 70 of Madison, passed away October 12, 2022. Stan was a Metro police officer for 30 years, and he considered it an honor and a privilege to serve the citizens of Nashville. After his retirement, he began working at Toliver's Pawn Shop in Madison where he enjoyed making jokes and deals with customers and the other employees, most of whom became close friends to him. He was a member of the Madison Masonic Lodge and the Al Menah Shrine Temple. Stan loved photography, airplanes, a cup of coffee and a smoke, The Beatles, and being from Scottsville, Kentucky. He never met a stranger, and once he considered you a friend, he never let you leave without telling you he loved you and asking, "Do you need anything?" 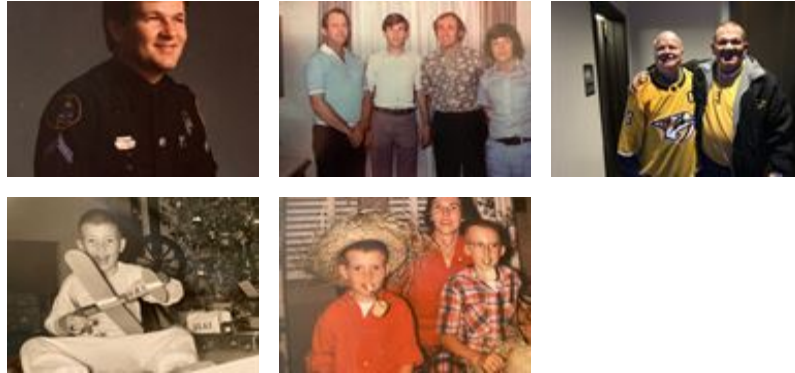
