



Thomas Clayton "Tom" Craven

October 25, 1936 - September 25, 2022

Thomas (Tom) Clayton Craven- passed away on September 25, 2022, at age 85 years

He was born on October 25, 1936, in Thomasville, North Carolina and he grew up in Carthage, North Carolina. He was the eldest son in a family of eight children. He graduated Farm Life High School and moved to Nashville to continue his education at Nashville Auto Diesel College. He had a lifelong passion for automobiles. He had no idea that his decision to pursue this field of study would lead him to the love of his life and make Nashville his lifelong home.

After graduating from NADC in 1957, he began a 20-year career with the Coca-Cola Bottling Company that began with him working on trucks in the body shop. After holding several positions of progressive responsibility, he was promoted to Production Manager over the bottling operation. During his time in this role, he was named Production Manager of the Year in 1968. While this was fulfilling work, his dream was to own a collision repair business. In 1976 he decided to make that dream come true. He started Craven's Body Shop in Inglewood while he was still working at Coca-Cola. His wife, Helen had quickly learned how to run a body shop and she did the day-to-day work for several months until Tom was able to leave his job. In 1977, he began working at the business full time and together they built a business that served the community for nearly 40 years. He worked tirelessly to serve customers with impeccable attention to detail and genuine pride in his work. It didn't

matter if it was a Cadillac or a Cavalier, he cared about the customer above all else. Over the years, he shared his knowledge and skills with many of his children and associates, several have continued to succeed in the industry due to what they learned from Tom.

He is preceded in death by his parents, Eston Egbert Craven and Flora Margaret McDuffie Craven, and his sister, Dolly Craven Taylor.

He is survived by his loving wife of 63 years, Helen Glenn Craven, and his children Liane (Jerry) McConnell, Suzanne Allen, Chris (Jody) Craven and Kim (Frank) Baker and grandchildren, Jeremy (Jessica) McConnell, Blake (Catherine) McConnell, Blaire (Kelly) Allen, Bradley (Amber) Allen, Brodie (Shanna) Allen, Brett (Bailey) Allen, Colbie (Candace) Craven, Hailey (Alex) Raynor, Sonny (Sarah) Baker, Lonnie Baker, Billy (James) Meadows, Sierra (Dylan) Hunt, Lucas Baker, Lainey Baker, Skylr Baker, Sophia Baker; and 19 great grandchildren.
