Veronica enjoyed sewing and was an active sewing blogger and a published pattern designer. She was a fine cook who enjoyed making her mother's recipes like sausage balls and cheese straws. A lover of Polish pottery and Christmas ornaments, she decorated a beautiful tree each year with her daughter. She also enjoyed flower gardening as well as taking care of her several adopted cats. No cat was ever a stranger, and outdoor strays sometimes became longtime family members because of her cat-whispering abilities.
