William Dwight Dozier "Bill", 74, of Lebanon, Tennessee, passed away on May 2, 2019 in Nashville, Tennessee. He was surrounded by family.

Bill was born to the late Jesse Emmett Dozier and Lenore Elizabeth Grasse Dozier on January 22, 1945 in Nashville, Tennessee.

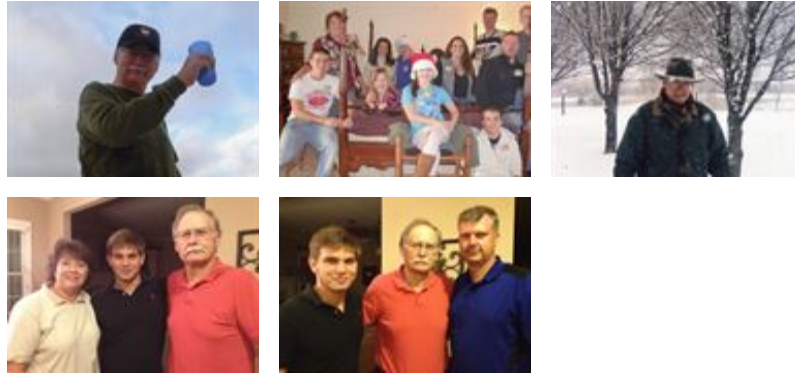
