



## William B. DeMontbreun

May 22, 1931 - September 12, 2014

Age 83, the son of the late James A. DeMontbreun, Sr. and Edna Neiderhauser DeMontbreun of Madison, TN passed away on Friday, September 12, 2014 at the Tennessee Veterans Home in Murfreesboro, TN after a long illness. He was preceded in death by his brother, James A. DeMontbreun, Jr. He is survived by his son, William Keith DeMontbreun of Chicago, IL; daughter, Pamela Sue DeMontbreun of Cookeville, TN; six grandchildren; sister, Mae Helen Diamond of Nashville, TN; twin brother, Wilbur R. He was a ROTC candidate while at Wyoming and was called to active duty for flight training in the United States Air Force in 1956. He served for several years in a Jet Fighter Reconnaissance Squadron in East Asia and returned to Nashville in 1959 after release from active duty. He then worked with several different accounting firms and in 1962 he opened his own accounting firm as a Certified Public Accountant (CPA) until his retirement in 2008 due to ill health. He was a member of the Church of Christ in Crossville, TN. Our loved one's wishes were that his remains be cremated.
