Brown, William Otley "Dr. Billy" was born at St. Thomas Hospital on April 30, 1927 to Aaron and Theona Brown and passed away July 18, 2016 at age 89. He was preceded in death by his parents, son, William Otley Brown Jr.; first wife, Vivian Askew Brown and his second wife, Jean Elrod Brown.
