William Avery Worsham passed from this life unexpectedly on Sunday, December 1, 2024. Following a Thanksgiving holiday surrounded by family and loved ones, Will was traveling back to school at UT Knoxville when he was in a car accident that ended his young life. He was 20 years old.

Will was born on May 3, 2004, to Diana Peters and Baron Worsham in Nashville, Tennessee. Will was a delightful child with a gentle spirit. He brought joy to his family who loved him without end. Will grew into a thoughtful, kind, and intelligent young man who worked hard to accomplish his dreams. He graduated with honors from Martin Luther King, Jr. Magnet School in 2022, and attended college at the University of Tennessee Knoxville where he was a Junior, majoring in Supply Chain Management. Throughout his life, Will loved spending time in the great outdoors of Tennessee and was an avid rock climber, car enthusiast, and entrepreneur.
