touched countless lives with her thoughtfulness, quick smile, and willingness to help others.

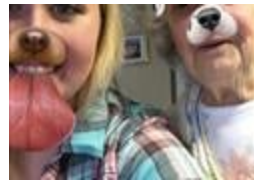
Winnie's life was one of dedication—to her family, her work, her community, and her many passions. She will be remembered fondly and deeply missed by all who knew her.
